SENATOR MOORE: I think we pretty well explained the bill on the committee amendments. I'd simply ask for advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Moore. Is there any further discussion on the advancement of LB 1194? Senator Moore, do you wish to waive closing?

SENATOR MOORE: I waive closing.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Closing is waived. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 1194 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 1194.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 1194 advances to E & R Initial. We now return to General File and take up on our discussion on LB 984.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 984 was discussed this morning. The next amendment, committee amendments have been offered. The next amendment I have to the committee amendments is by Senator Hall. Senator, this is your amendment that would strike Sections 9, 10, 11 of the committee amendments, the one you gave me yesterday.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Madam President, members. Mr. Clerk, is this a handwritten amendment?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR HALL: This is strike Sections 9, 10, 11?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR HALL: Dealing with the income tax credit? I'd withdraw that amendment.

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Madam President, Mr. Clerk, I would ask to
