SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the opening. Any discussion? There is none. Senator Wesely, to close.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay, no, thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wesely waives closing. The question is the adoption of the Wesely amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The amendment is adopted. Anything else on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator McKenzie.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Mr. Speaker, I would move LB 498A be advanced to E & R final.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the motion. Is there any discussion? Seeing none, all in favor vote aye. Opposed. LB 498A is advanced. Next item, Mr. Clerk, LB 570.

CLERK: Mr. President, 570, E & R amendments pending, Senator.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator McKenzie.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Mr. Speaker, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The motion is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All in favor vote aye. Opposed. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler had an amendment printed, Senator, AM2502 from last year.
