LB 1044, 1222, 1222A

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1222.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1222 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, LB 1222A.

CLERK: LB 1222A, a bill offered by Senator Wesely. (Read title.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wesely, on the A bill.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. Speaker, members, this A bill is all cash funded out of the Insurance Department Cash Fund. It would work to implement the bill dealing with the establishment of the reinsurance pool and the board that's required and also, obviously, there's a standards benefits plan included. And so for those administrative functions, this bill would provide for the cash funds to carry those out. With that, I would be happy to answer questions, and move for the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: You've heard the opening. Is there any discussion? Closing, Senator Wesely? The question is the advancement of LB 1222A. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1222A.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1222A advances. Mr. Clerk, LB 1044.

CLERK: LB 1044, introduced by Senator Vrtiska, Bromm, Engel and Hartnett. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 11 of this year, referred to the Transportation Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Transportation Committee amendments, Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and members of the Legislature, this particular piece of legislation, LB 1044, deals with 911 services and the funding of those particular services. This is Senator Vrtiska's bill and I will let him get into the policy, but I want to explain the committee amendments.
