

SENATOR LINDSAY: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Lindsay, with this amendment to the committee amendments, as I understand it, two juvenile court judges are being added, but at different points in time. Is that...

SENATOR LINDSAY: That's correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's correct. And what is the fiscal note that would be associated with this particular amendment?

SENATOR LINDSAY: I don't know because it hasn't run through Fiscal Office, because it hasn't been adopted to the bill yet.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. I assume it's safe to assume it's probably at least 100,000 for each judge?

SENATOR LINDSAY: Oh, I would think so, and that's one of the reasons we delayed it in to probably two years, it's simply to keep the fiscal note from getting too large.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so we have 100,000 for each of those two, and with the original two in the bill...

SENATOR LINDSAY: It would be...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...(inaudible), so we're up...we have five judges altogether now. If the amendment to the committee amendment is adopted, we would have two juvenile judges, one county judge, and two district judges...

SENATOR LINDSAY: At different times.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...added at different times.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Three of them at once, one July 1st of '95, and another one July 1st of '96.

SENATOR LINDSAY: No, two of them would be July 1 of '94, two July 1, '95, one July 1, '96.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so the total fiscal note in the end
