That may be a problem, I can't fault Senator Chambers for calling that to our attention, but let's not penalize the kids in Douglas County, and that's what I see the failure to adopt the amendment would be, penalizing the kids in Douglas and Sarpy County rather than, as Senator Chambers says, rewarding incompetents. I don't see it as doing that, I think the amendment ought to be adopted and I would urge you to vote to do so.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the Lindsay amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Mr. Clerk. Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: I would call for a...or ask for a call of the house, and I would accept call-in votes.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The question is, shall the house go under call? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to go under call.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on adoption of Senator Lindsay's amendment.
