

General File, allowing for public accountancy firms to use nonpublic accountants. There was a second measure that was brought to the committee by the Board of Public Accountancy to allow them to use the costs which has been imposed by their boards into their own cash fund, and then divert civil penalties, which are collected by the board, to the permanent school fund. That bill was reported out. It was LB 1009. There was public hearing. There was no opposition. It was reported out unanimously. This amendment places the provisions of LB 1009 into 957 and takes care of all of the Board of Accountancy issues in one bill. It will then say, if this amendment is adopted, that nonaccountants can be members of a public accountancy firm and partners, and that the Board of Accountancy can impose costs in disciplinary proceedings, including attorneys fees, hearing officer fees, expenses, and that costs go into the Cash Fund and civil penalties go into the permanent school fund. I will be happy to answer any questions. Otherwise, I would ask for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any discussion on the Landis amendment? Seeing none, Senator Landis, closing? Has been waived. The question is the adoption of the Landis amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Landis's amendment.
