LB 637, 1243, 1287A

CLERK: LB 1287A, Senator, I have no amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator McKenzie.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: I move the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: All in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. LB 1243.

CLERK: LB 1243, I have no E & R. Senator Moore has an amendment to the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Moore. Is that Senator Moore.

CLERK: Senator Moore.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Don't see Senator Moore. We will pass over. Senator Hall.

CLERK: Senator, he has...I think the one you want to handle is AM3847.

SENATOR HALL: Is that the...Mr. President, member, Mr. Clerk, is that the amendment that we have in front of us?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR HALL: That is the amendment that is filed? This amendment is the...it is LB 637, and Senator Moore is here, and I would relinquish the balance of his opening on the amendment. Senator Moore.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Thank you very much. Obviously, I am winded easily. I am winded from running upstairs. But if you...

SPEAKER WITHEM: Would you like somebody younger to handle the amendment for you?

SENATOR MOORE: If the Pages would pass this out, please. If you look in your bill books at LB 637, that is the amendment. The change between the bill, and the amendment that was printed, and the one today was a small change in dates. What it does is basically six things, four things. The one is change lobbyist
