

he knows that the body more than likely not accept this amendment because it takes it back originally to a point where the Revenue Committee decided, and I think rightly so, that the form won't work. It has to be in the form that it is in now, and it certainly is doable, but because this certainly is going to take the rest of the 15 minutes, I will be drafting 972 in the form that it is in now to amend it to another bill, or it may come up on its own on Select File where we are not restrained by 15 minutes. At that point I think the bill will move in its right form, and at this point I would move that we go on to the next bill and we pass over this bill.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. We will pass over the bill then. The next item on the agenda, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator, LB 908, I do have E & R amendments pending.

SENATOR HALL: Senator McKenzie, on the E & R amendments.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Thank you, Mr. President. I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

SENATOR HALL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed. They are adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SENATOR HALL: Senator McKenzie.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Mr. President, I would move LB 908 be advanced to E & R Final.

SENATOR HALL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed. The bill is advanced. We will now move to Item 2 on the agenda. Absolutely, we can do some items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. A new A bill, LB 1243A. (Read by title for the first time.) Natural Resources Committee reports LB 953 and LB 958 to General File.
