**SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING**

**SPEAKER WITHEM:** Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. As we begin today, the forty-fourth legislative day, I would like to begin by hearing our prayer this morning from Father Tim Anderson from St. Stephens Episcopal Church in Grand Island.
