SPEAKER WITHEM: Will all members please check in. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I would ask that that roll call in reverse order be started with Senator Withem.

SPEAKER WITHEM: I'll take that under consideration. Senator Lynch, would you check in, please. Senator Ashford, Senator Chambers, Senator Pirsch, Senator Engel. Senator Matzke, check in, please. All members not excused are in the Chamber. Would you proceed with calling the roll in reverse order.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1344-45 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 24 ayes, 16 nays.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 248 does not pass. We will not read LB 248A. The Final Reading is completed and we will proceed with LB 37, General File.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may right before that, some items. Mr. President, new resolutions. (Read brief summary of LR 349 as found on pages 1345-46 of the Legislative Journal.) Mr. President, I have a communication from the Speaker referring LR 349 to committee, to the Reference Committee for purposes of conducting a public hearing. Mr. President, Senator Abboud would like to have an Exec Session of the Business and Labor Committee now in Room 2022. Business and Labor Committee.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Let me make the following announcement. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign engrossed LB 211, LB 211A, LB 291, LB 291A, LB 436, LB 436A, LB 1001, LB 1001A, LB 498 and LB 498A. General File, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 37 was originally introduced by Senator Moore. (Read title.) The bill was introduced in January of last year, at that time referred to the Revenue Committee. The bill was discussed on March 16 this year on the floor. At that time, committee amendments were offered. Senator Beutler moved to amend the committee amendments with AM3687.
