PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 987 pass? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 1462-63 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 40 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting.
