ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 511 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 511 pass? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1587 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 25 ayes, 19 nays.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 511 passes. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 683, LB 1129, LB 908, LB 941, LB 1002, LB 1127, along with LB 511. Mr. Clerk, any items for the record? (See page 1587 of the Legislative Journal.)

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and reviewed LB 1351 and recommend that same be placed on Select File. Natural Resources Committee reports LB 1219 to General File with committee amendments attached. (See pages 1587-91 of the Legislative Journal.)
