SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Warner. Discussion on the Hall amendment to the Warner amendment? Senator Wesely. Senator Warner, you have spoken, I assume, Senator Hall on the Hall amendment. Senator Vrtiska, on the Hall amendment.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I'd like to address a question to Senator Hall if I could, please.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Senator Hall, I guess I'm a little bit lost here. I was trying to figure out what your...maybe you need to explain to me a little bit more, but I guess what I'm getting is that you're trying to cut down the paperwork so that they wouldn't have to report those incomes on those forms for...

SENATOR HALL: No, no, no.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay, explain it to me because you lost me somewhere.

SENATOR HALL: That's fine and I apologize. The amendment was just before us and I...all I strike, Senator Vrtiska, on page 10 of the AM4130, line 16 where it reads, it says the form shall require but not be limited to, I would just strike "but not be limited to". In other words, it says the form shall require the attachment of the applicant's federal income tax. What I don't want to see happen, and it's not...I want to see, actually I was one that required that the folks on the homestead, it was a proposal that we put forth out of the Revenue Committee when I sat on it, to require that they apply annually because it was not happening at that time and there were many people who weren't eligible that were receiving it. What we're doing now I believe in 910 which becomes part of 902 is, we're getting more income information to make sure that people are qualified and I believe that that is a good proposal. What I don't want to see happen though is that we end up with a reporting mechanism that is so overburdensome that the individuals who truly need it cannot comply with the reporting requirements to make themselves
