SENATOR WARNER: Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: Thank you, Mr. President. The amendment that I have today is LB 1223A, and it brings to the A bill the necessary funding that we use to implement that part of LB 1223 dealing with the family practice residency programs over at Creighton and at Clarkson, and this is the...this is the money, this is the funding that was stricken by a veto, line-item veto last year in the Governor's vetoes, and we have asked that that be replaced. It allows for \$50,000 for this current year, and \$22,500 for next year. I ask your support for that amendment.
