CLERK:     26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1349.

SENATOR MOORE: LB 1349 is advanced. LB 1349A.

CLERK:     Mr. President, 1349A, a bill introduced by Senator Avery, appropriates funds to implement the provisions of LB 1349.

SENATOR MOORE: Senator Avery, do you wish to open on LB 1349A?

SENATOR AVERY: Thank you, Mr. President. 1349A is the A bill for that. We have that, it is a one-time General Fund appropriation of 50,000 primarily to go for the department to promulgate and establish the procedures and the rules that they're going to use for this fund. It will be repaid as dollars come in from the private sector, so I want to make that perfectly clear that the intent here is to repay those funds so it initially will not be costing the state any dollars to do that. With that, thank you.

SENATOR MOORE: Thank you, Senator Avery. No other lights on, no closing. The motion is the advancement of LB 1349A to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The Clerk will record.

CLERK:     26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 1349A.

SENATOR MOORE: LB 1349A is advanced. Clerk, do you have anything for the record?

CLERK:     Mr. President, new resolution, LR 496 by Senator Robak. That will be laid over. Senator Bromm has amendments to LB 903 and I received a report from the State Claims Board. That will be on file in the Clerk's office. (See page 1747 of the Legislative Journal.

Mr. President, LB 1022, next bill, was introduced by Senator Robak. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10, referred to the Natural Resources Committee, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.
