CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Final Reading is complete. We move to General File, A bills, LB 902. Oh, you bet, go ahead and read some things first.

CLERK: Mr. President, bills read on Final Reading this morning had been presented to the Governor. (Re: LB 991, LB 1045, LB 1311, LB 1006, LB 1006A, LB 1194, LB 1211, LB 1211A, LB 314, LB 971, LB 971A and LB 665.) New resolutions. (Read brief summaries of LRs 497-498. See pages 1789-90 of the Legislative Journal.) I have a reference or a letter from the Speaker referring those two resolutions to Reference Committee. (Read brief summaries of LRs 499-501. See pages 1790-92 of the Legislative Journal.) And I have an Attorney General's Opinion addressed to Senator Hall. (Re: LB 718. See pages 1792-95 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. LB 902A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 902A was introduced by Senator Wickersham. (Read title.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wickersham, 902A.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. If you recall, the last time LB 902 was before the body on Select File, provisions were amended into the bill providing for a homestead exemption. LB 902A is the appropriations bill necessary to implement those sections. The other provisions of 902A did not require an appropriations bill. It is only the homestead exemptions that were amended in on Select File that require the appropriation.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Any discussion? Senator Moore. Senator Moore waives off. Any further discussion? Senator Wickersham, to close. The motion is to advance LB 902A. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.
