LB 408, 1049, 1088

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator McKenzie.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Mr. Speaker, I move LB 408 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: All in favor say aye. Opposed. LB 408 is advanced.

CLERK: LB 1088, Senator, I have no amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator McKenzie.

SENATOR MCKENZIE: Mr. Speaker, I move LB 1088 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: All in favor say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. Let me pause here, let Senator McKenzie take a deep breath here, and introduce some guests of the Legislature. Under the north balcony, from Imperial, Nebraska, we have the mayor, Dean Mitchell, Jasmine Mitchell, Callie Weiss, and Logan Pribbens. Stand and be recognized.
