LB 607, 913, 1068, 1245

**PRESIDENT ROBAK:** All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 913 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay. Please record.

**ASSISTANT CLERK:** (Record vote read. See page 1827 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 44 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting.

**PRESIDENT ROBAK:** LB 913 passes with the emergency clause attached. Now turn to consent calendar and LB 1068.

**CLERK:** Madam President, the first item on 1068 are Enrollment and Review amendments. Senator McKenzie.

**PRESIDENT ROBAK:** Senator McKenzie.

**SENATOR MCKENZIE:** Madam President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

**PRESIDENT ROBAK:** Any discussion? Seeing none, all those in favor vote aye...say aye. All those opposed nay. The amendments are adopted.

**CLERK:** Senator Wickersham would move to amend the bill, Madam President. (AM3946 appears on pages 1410-11 of the Legislative Journal.)

**PRESIDENT ROBAK:** Senator Wickersham.

**SENATOR WICKERSHAM:** Thank you, Madam President. This is a retirement bill so I guess you could expect to hear from me this morning. I'm not going to take 30 minutes, obviously, we don't have that much time this morning on this consent calendar. The amendment you have is in the Journal. It's on page 1411. It was LB 1245. It's the contents of LB 1245. LB 1245 deals with the retirement plans for firefighters from first class cities. It is really a piece of work that was left over from last year. The contents of 1245 were largely contained within the original bill of LB 607 last year. There was a compromise. These provisions were left out so that the parties could work on them over the interim. They have. There is now agreement between the League of Municipalities and the firefighters concerning the content of LB 1245. LB 1245 does just a couple of things. First of all, it provides that a firefighter who retires
