do last year. These I think are somewhat flimsy if we are trying to separate that from the thing that happened on LB 1026. I think they are completely different things. I think if we actually take a step back and look at them, I think we all know that. I think the policy that we established then of going back in and not putting things to the status quo, I think was wrong. I think it should have been back, but I still adhere to that. I still think that when we do make those mistakes, where we're in a situation where we have to have some trust, I think we have to do that. And in this situation, I think it is very clearly a case where it is not what was intended by the Legislature, and because of that, I can't vote for a bracket motion. I can't vote against the advancement of the bill. I had to make the point, not that I know that anybody, that I swayed anybody. Frankly, I guess it doesn't matter. I simply had to do it for myself. With that, I would withdraw the bracket motion.

SENATOR WITHEM: The motion is withdrawn. The call is raised. Mr. Clerk, further items?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, may I read some items before that.

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, go right ahead and read some items.

CLERK: Mr. President, bills read on Final Reading this morning have been presented to the Governor. (Re: LB 942, LB 1106, LB 1106A, and LB 913.) Lobby Registration Report for this past week will be inserted in the Journal. A new resolution, LR 503 offered by Senator Hall. That will be laid over; and Senator Robinson would like to print amendments to LB 1034. (See pages 1835-37 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, the next amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Ashford. Senator, I have separate amendments, two of which I believe you've indicated you want to withdraw.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Yes.

CLERK: Senator Ashford, I then have your amendment AM4351, Senator, found on page 1727.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Yes, that's the amendment that I would like to run. There were a couple of motions, I believe, which I would ask to be withdrawn as well.
