SENATOR HALL: Thank you. The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 10 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR HALL: The house is under call. Will all members please return to the Chamber, record their presence. The house is under call. Senator Schellpeper, accept call-in votes? Yes. Thank you very much. The question before the body is the adoption of the Schellpeper amendment to the Beutler amendment. House is under call. Members, please return to the Chamber, record their presence.

CLERK: Senator Pedersen voting yes. Senator Kristensen voting yes. Senator Elmer voting yes. Senator Hudkins voting yes.

SENATOR HALL: Senators Matzke, McKenzie, Monen. Senator Bohlke, Pedersen, Price (sic) and Pirsch. Senator Rasmussen, Senator Day. Senator Wickersham, Senator Witek, would you all please return to the Chamber, record your presence. The house is under call.

CLERK: Senator Coordsen voting yes. Senator Fisher voting yes. Senator Monen voting yes.

SENATOR HALL: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the Schellpeper amendment to the Beutler amendment.

SENATOR HALL: The Schellpeper amendment is adopted. If I could ask members, please, to stay close to the Chamber, even though we're going to raise the call. Next...anything further on the Beutler amendment, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further pending to Senator Beutler's amendment at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR HALL: We are back to discussion of the Beutler amendment. Senator Wesely, your light is next.
