

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Warner amendment.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Warner amendment is adopted. Further discussion, Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, if I could just ask Senator Warner a question about his amendment. Senator Warner, did your amendment, I just noticed it when I started reading it here that it's not, I guess, a big deal, but it has that same language in the first paragraph and also in the first premise. I don't know if you made the change in the two places in there...

SENATOR WARNER: No, I...

SENATOR LINDSAY: ...or if you think it's necessary to.

SENATOR WARNER: I just made it in that opening sentence because I was concerned it gives an implication. There are other areas in the resolution that questions come to mind, but that's inherent questions in the English language with adjectives, but...

SENATOR LINDSAY: Okay, that's more I guess just to call it to your attention to see if there was a concern.

SENATOR WARNER: Perhaps it should have been changed both, I did not do that.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Okay, thank you, Senator.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Further discussion on LR 502? Senator Wesely, closing? Closing is waived. The question is the adoption of LR 502. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
