

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now the second part of your amendment says on page 2...are you with me? On page 2 put a period after the word "program", on page 2, line 25. Correct?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, now would you read the sentence, would you read the complete sentence starting in line 24 that you're going to shorten by putting a period. Would you read that for me, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Starting on line 24.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: A residential valuation program.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Period, that's what you said.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Period.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: What does that mean?

SENATOR CUDABACK: That just means that program will be...it simply drops that program, that particular program you're talking about shall not be necessarily established in a county containing a city of the metropolitan class.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But when you put a period after "program" all you have said in this sentence is "A residential evaluation program."

SENATOR CUDABACK: Well, all you're saying in the rest of the line is it shall be placed there, so you...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right, you give a complete sentence. Yours is not even a sentence. All it says is a residential evaluation program, period.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's all it will say.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Correct.
