

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I see five hands. The question before you...Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I would ask that you not acknowledge the calling of the question on the basis that there has not been a full and fair debate.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Beutler, I...Senator Lynch.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Beutler, I rule that there has been sufficient debate on this motion. The question before you is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Senator Lynch.

SENATOR LYNCH: Madam President, I reluctantly suggest we check in and have a roll call vote.

We're waiting for Senator Warner, Senator Schellpeper, Senator Schimek, Senator Cudaback, Senator Hartnett, Senator Elmer, Senator McKenzie, Senator Hall, Senator Lindsay. We're waiting for Senators Warner, Schellpeper and Lindsay. There has been a request for a roll call vote. The question before you is, shall debate cease on the motion to return LB 860 to Select File? Mr. Clerk, please proceed.
