

SENATOR ROBINSON: No.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, no. So it's your intent that they, in the first priority...that they should go to the second priority at some point in time after certain school districts have been satisfied with respect to the first priority?

SENATOR ROBINSON: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. What school districts do you intend not to be satisfied in the first priority category in favor of satisfaction of second priority requests?

SENATOR ROBINSON: Well, I think one factor would be how many apply. And I...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: One minute.

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...and in looking at the...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, let's as...

SENATOR ROBINSON: You want me to finish? And it depends on the hookups that...from other sources of funding. I think you have to look at the whole state. I mean you're not just looking at schools that would be hooked up by the Weatherization Fund. You'd have to look at the state as a whole on whether they're hooked up or not,...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR ROBINSON: ...whether it's from a telephone company, or whether it's from an ESU or an innovative grant.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Let me ask you the question maybe in terms of a specific example. Let's say that in your first priority you had 50 school...you had enough money for 50 school districts and those 50 school districts all needed the money in order to do...they would all qualify for the direct connection money because, with respect to ability to need...need...

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...or ability to pay....
