AN ACT relating to the Governor; to authorize the Governor to designate official state items.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The Governor may designate official state items, including animals, plants, minerals, and other things. Legislative approval of any such designation is not required. Any designation made on or prior to the effective date of this act is not affected by this section.
