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SENATOR HILGERT: And veterans, disabled veterans.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right. Now if they are the ones who are going to get this refund, those people, the ones you listed would not include all of the ones who might have a difficulty paying this extra tax of the 50 cents?

SENATOR HILGERT: That is absolutely true.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And I can't continue so I will wait until he calls on us, and I hope if he calls you, we can continue this discussion.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Time. Senator Abboud.

SENATOR ABOUD: Question.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Do I see five hands? I do. Question before the body now then is, shall debate now cease on the pending motion to reconsider? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted on the motion to cease debate? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 1 nay to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Debate is not ceased. Senator Hilgert.

SENATOR HILGERT: I yield my time to Senator Chambers and, hopefully, we can keep up this dialogue for a little while.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, we will. Thank you, Senator Hilgert. Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, Senator Hilgert, are renters entitled to the homestead exemption?

SENATOR HILGERT: No, they are not.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Are there other classifications, if I can use that term, groups or individuals who are not entitled to the homestead exemption but who, nevertheless, have telephones?

SENATOR HILGERT: Yes.
