SENATOR CROSBY: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...which contribute to the overcrowding.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Wehrbein, followed by Dwite Pedersen, Schimek, Beutler, and Bromm. Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Madam Speaker, members, I would like to yield my time or omit my time and go to Senator Pedersen, if he would like to talk on this. I know he's knowledgeable on this particular area. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Dwite Pedersen.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Madam President, members of the Legislature, I'm appalled. I was listening to Senator Chambers talk. I have not read the paper yet, the front page, and I knew that the Governor had vetoed a bunch of money, but 760,000 out of Corrections? I mean Wednesday nights I work so I didn't get it...read it then and I haven't read it yet this morning, but I'm going to read that. Seven hundred and sixty thousand out of staffing when we are overcrowded and about to...a state out there where we're going to have...we've already got serious problems. When we are overcrowded, that's when the staffing is needed the most. The tension is bad. NSP, the Nebraska State Pen, and these are some other things we need to look at besides the good time and the mandatory minimums or whatever we're looking at in all them areas, but NSP last year with approximately 920 to 950 prisoners had 10,000 write-ups, disciplinary write-ups. Now I would guess that, and I'm not accurate here so please don't hold me to these figures, but I would guess that probably 70 percent of them were acted on, 30 percent were dropped as being frivolous. And out of that 70 percent there would have been a loss of good time and a loss of good time would cost us, as you talked about, so you've still got 7,000 write-ups, you talk a'out at least a minimum of a month extra in prison for each one of them write-ups.
