

TRANSCRIPT PREPARED BY THE CLERK OF THE LEGISLATURE
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LB 512

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Madam President, I'll move the E & R amendments to LB 512.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, the question before you is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 512. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, Senator Chambers would move to indefinitely postpone the bill.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers to open on his motion to indefinitely postpone.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, nobody who's on this bill is here, so maybe we ought to pass over it until they can locate somebody whose bill it is, because I don't know whether they want to lay it over or what...how they'd want to proceed with it. I would ask unanimous consent to pass over it temporarily.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any objection? There's an objection. Senator Chambers, my understanding is that...that the Senator is on his way up, that he was listening on television and should be here shortly.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then I'm going to...my time can be running, but I'm going to forego speaking until he gets here.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Your time will continue to run, Senator. Senator Chambers, time is running, so we are under the ten minute opening period Senator Chambers would have on his motion to indefinitely postpone. Senator Will, Senator Chambers has moved to indefinitely postpone LB 512. You have the option of laying the bill over.

SENATOR WILL: I'll take it up.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Will. Senator Chambers.
