SENATOR PREISTER: I will accept the machine vote, I would just ask that I have a record vote, please.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. A record vote has been requested. We are voting on the Preister amendment. Have you all voted? Record, please. And a record vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 598-99 of the Legislative Journal.) 6 ayes, 19 nays on the amendment.
