SENATOR BRUNING:    Mr. President, I move LB 309 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:    Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:    Mr. Speaker, I'll be very brief. I still am not in support of LB 309, but I want to express my appreciation to Senator Bromm and his staff and the others for how they worked on this bill. I know that it was difficult in some cases relinquishing certain things that were in the bill, but they know that I suffered my pain also. I will not vote for the bill, but I'm not going to ask for a machine vote so it won't have to necessarily show up, but I still am in opposition to the bill itself.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:    You've heard the motion. All those in favor of advancing LB 309 to E & R for engrossing say aye. All those opposed say nay. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

Senator Kiel, amendments to 309; Senator Brown to 1063; Senator Wesely, 1063; Senator Bautler, (LB) 1063. And Senator Abboud would like to add his name to 309 as cointroducer.
