PRESIDENT ROBAK: The amendment is withdrawn. We are on Final Reading. Will senators please return to their seats. We are on Final Reading. Senators, please return to your seats. Final Reading, LB 204.

CLERK: (Read LB 204 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall LB 204 pass? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1557 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 1 nay, 2 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 204 passes. Senator Brashear announces that the following guests are visiting the Legislature. There are 56 eighth grade students here from Mary Our Queen School in Omaha with their teachers. (Introduced teachers.) They are seated in the north balcony. Will you all stand and be recognized, please. Welcome to the Nebraska Legislature. LB 204A.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 204A pass? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1558 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 1 nay, 5 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting.
