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Committee, being diligent, thought that we ought to insert the phase, "but shall reside within the state". And in order that we not have our Supreme Court sitting at exotic spots at taxpayer expense, we urge the adoption of the committee amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Brashear. Senator Beutler, to speak to the committee amendments.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Brashear, a question, if I may.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes, Madam President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: It's perhaps a more local question than you expect, but there is language in the green copy that I assume is retained that says, "The offices of the Chief Justice and Judges of the Supreme Court shall be at the place where the court is located." And I assume that that means...

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Could you point me to the line, please, Senator Beutler?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Lines 13 and 14 on page 1.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes, thank you.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I assume what we're saying here is that the residences can be anywhere, but as far as the expenses of maintaining an office are concerned, they're going to be maintaining one office and that's where the court's located. Is that...is that accurate?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: That is my understanding of the intent of the bill, yes, and the phrase.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Because I...and I would invite Senator Kristensen to...

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Senator Abboud, you mean?
