A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to Joslyn Castle; to amend sections 72-1801 and
2 72-1802, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
3 provisions relating to the Joslyn Castle Trust Fund; to
4 change funding provisions; to provide intent; to
5 eliminate an obsolete reference; to repeal the original
6 sections; and to declare an emergency.
7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 72-1801, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 72-1801. The Department of Administrative Services may
4 enter into agreements for the operation, administration,
5 maintenance, restoration, and renovation of Joslyn Castle and may
6 accept gifts, grants, and bequests for the operation,
7 administration, maintenance, restoration, and renovation of Joslyn
8 Castle. It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate two
9 hundred thousand dollars from the General Fund for FY2000-01 and
10 each year thereafter for the operation, administration, and
11 maintenance of Joslyn Castle and that no General Funds shall be
12 expended for the renovation, restoration, or tenant improvements.

14 Sec. 2. Section 72-1802, Reissue Revised Statutes of
15 Nebraska, is amended to read:

16 72-1802. There is hereby created the Joslyn Castle Trust
17 Fund to be administered by the Department of Administrative
18 Services. The fund shall consist of money appropriated by the
19 Legislature and such sums as are contributed as gifts, grants, or
20 bequests. The fund shall be used only for the operation,
21 administration, maintenance, restoration, and renovation of Joslyn
22 Castle. Any money in the fund available for investment shall be
23 invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska
24 Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.

25 Sec. 3. Original sections 72-1801 and 72-1802, Reissue
26 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.

27 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
28 when passed and approved according to law.
