A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to juveniles; to amend section 43-411, Reissue
2 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions
3 relating to detainers for apprehension and detention; and
4 to repeal the original section.
5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 43-411, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 43-411. The Director of Health and Human Services shall
4 have the authority, and may delegate the authority ~~only~~ to the
5 Administrator of the Office of Juvenile Services, the deputy
6 directors of the Department of Health and Human Services, and the
7 superintendents of the youth rehabilitation and treatment centers,
8 to issue detainers for the apprehension and detention of juveniles
9 who have absconded from a placement with or commitment to the
10 office. Any peace officer who detains a juvenile on such a
11 detainer shall hold the juvenile in an appropriate facility or
12 program for juveniles until the office can take custody of the
13 juvenile.
