Introducer’s Statement of Intent
LB 50

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 50 creates a Child Support Commission composed of 10 members appointed by the Legislature and the Nebraska Supreme Court.

The commission would be composed of: two professionals in the field of economics, mathematics, or other field relevant to the area of child support; two judges; two members of the Nebraska State Bar; two members of the Legislature; a custodial parent; and a noncustodial parent.

The commission is required to review the current child support guidelines and make recommendations concerning any amendments to the guidelines to the Supreme Court. The Supreme Court is required to review the commission’s recommendation and may amend the guidelines accordingly.
