

LEGISLATIVE BILL 900A

Approved by the Governor March 22, 2000

Introduced by Schrock, 38

AN ACT relating to appropriations; to amend Laws 1999, LB 92A, section 1; and Laws 1999, LB 880, sections 120, 121, 167 to 175, and 262; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 900, Ninety-sixth Legislature, Second Session, 2000; to change appropriations as prescribed; to provide for transfers; to provide an operative date; to repeal the original sections; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

The unexpended General Fund, Cash Fund, and Federal Fund est. balances existing on June 30, 2000, in Agency 55, Nebraska Natural Resources Commission, Programs 44, 303, 304, 306, 307, 308, 309, 310, and 334, are hereby reappropriated to Agency 29, Department of Natural Resources, Programs 44, 303, 304, 306, 307, 308, 309, 310, and 334.

Sec. 15. This act shall become operative on July 1, 2000.

Sec. 16. Original Laws 1999, LB 92A, section 1; and Laws 1999, LB 880, sections 120, 121, 167 to 175, and 262, are repealed.

Sec. 17. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
