SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Coordsen, you're recognized to introduce your motion.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Mr. Speaker, movers of...members of the body, I move that a series of committees be appointed to escort the various state and constitutional officers for the purpose of administering their oaths of office. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the motion. All those in favor of adopting the motion to appoint the Escort Committees for the constitutional and state officers for inauguration purposes this afternoon say aye. Those opposed say nay. Motion passes. Members, we're going to attempt to try to get as many bills introduced this morning as we can. We'd ask your cooperation.
