PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Members, the other set of doughnuts that will be passed out are being distributed today by (sic) Senator Bob Kremer's birthday, which is today. Senator Kremer, happy birthday. (Applause.)

"Mother Superior" does not have the authority to change anybody from committee to committee.
