SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning our chaplain for the day is Father Paul Witt. He's from St. Mary's Parish, here in Lincoln. Father.
