SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature, if I could just have your attention for a moment and try to give you some guideline of where we're going to go this morning, we're going to have bill introduction from now until ten o'clock. At ten o'clock we're going to start with the agenda at LR 16, and then we'll move directly from there to the General File Revisor bills. We're going to try to get everything. This is the last day of bill introduction, so if you've got bills in your office that need to get filed, today's the last day to do it. We're going to try to be done by noon, which means we'd like to have all the bills in by 11:30 a.m. And so that...that gives you a little over two hours to get all the bills in, and then we're going to process them and we'll be open until we get them all processed, but we're going to try to put a cutoff at 11:30 a.m. So if you have a bill, today at 11:30 a.m. is the last time to get it in. And we'll pick back up at ten o'clock. Thank you, Mr. President.
