January 20, 1999 LB 7, 8, 9

CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 7.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 7 is advanced to E & R Initial.

CLERK: LB 9, Mr. President, by Senator Coordsen, as Chair of the Executive Board. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 7, referred to General File, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Coordsen, you're recognized to open on LB 8.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Mr. President, members of the body, LB 8, as the Clerk indicated, repeals a provision governing marriages and divorces prior to April 8, 1919. I would move for the advancement of LB 8.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. Seeing no lights, you're recognized to close. Senator Coordsen waives closing. Question is the advancement of LB 8. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of Legislative Bill 8.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. LB 8 is advanced to E & R Initial.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 9, by Senator Coordsen. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 7. The bill was referred directly to General File.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you. The Chair recognizes Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. LB 9 repeals language, obsolete language, relating to the Department of Social Services and the transition of employees. I would move for the advancement of LB 9. Thank you, Mr. President.
