PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. Seeing no lights, you're recognized to close. Senator Coordsen waives closing. The question is the advancement of LB 9. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 9.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 9 is advanced to E & R Initial.

CLERK: LB 10, Mr. President, by Senator Coordsen, as Chair of the Board. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 7, 1999, and referred directly to General File.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Coordsen, you're recognized to open on LB 10.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. LB 10 repeals obsolete language governing the Task Force on Electronic Access to state government information. I would move for the advancement of LB 10. Thank you, Mr. President.
