And upon conversations with them last week, they've informed me that this task force will not be ready for a report for some time. So I thought it would be better that I withdraw the bill at this time, and then most likely will reintroduce it next year. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Hudkins. Seeing no lights, would you like to close on your motion? Members, the motion before us is to withdraw LB 197. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay; majority of those voting.... Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to withdraw LB 197.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The motion to withdraw LB 197 is successful. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Select File. Senator Smith, LB 1, I have no amendments to the bill, Senator.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Yes, thank you, Mr. President. I move LB 1 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The motion is to advance LB 1 to E & R. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Excuse me, let's start again. Voice vote. Those in favor vote aye. Those opposed. Motion carries.

CLERK: LB 2, Senator, I have no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: I move LB 2 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. Those in favor of advancing LB 2. Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.
