CLERK: I have nothing further pending to the committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Is there discussion on the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Bohlke, you're recognized to close on the committee amendments. Senator Bohlke waives closing. The motion before us are the committee amendments to LB 195. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Committee amendments are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Motion is to advance to E & R Initial. Seeing no lights, Senator Suttle, you are recognized to close.

SENATOR SUTTLE: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I would just move that we advance this bill. It is a technical bill and I appreciate your support. Thank you very much.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The motion before us is to advance LB 195 to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 195.
