If you don't think that's necessary then oppose it; you don't think that education is necessary. And what we have in our National Guard, which I'm proud of, I'm proud of our National Guard, I'm proud of our reserves too. I wish we could do it for both of them. But right now I think that our main objective should be for the National Guard, so I ask for your support on LB 243. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The motion before us is the advancement of LB 243 to E & R for...to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 243.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 243 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. New A bills. (Read LB 119A and LB 68A by title for the first time.) Hearing notices from Natural Resources Committee and from Transportation, signed by their respective Chairs. Government Committee reports LB 212 to General File. Revenue reports (LB) 32 to General File; Revenue, (LB) 232, General File; (LB) 669, General File; (LB) 244, indefinitely postponed; (LB) 269, indefinitely postponed. Judiciary reports (LB) 64 to General File; (LB) 106, General File; (LB) 40, General File with amendments; likewise with LB 46, (LB) 49, (LB) 511, and (LB) 280...or (LB) 280 is from Revenue Committee. That's report to General File with amendments. Those reports all signed by respective Chairs.

A new bill, Mr. President, introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read LB 881 by title for the first time.) That's all that I had, Mr. President. (See pages 406-410 of the Legislative Journal.)
