PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The motion is to amend LB 119 (sic--119A). Is there any discussion? Seeing none, Senator, you're recognized to close on your amendment. Senator Crosby waives closing. Motion before us is the Crosby amendment to LB 119A. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Crosby's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted. Other discussion? Seeing none, Senator Crosby, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. I waive closing, more or less. I do have numbers if anybody's interested in the total fiscal note. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Crosby. The motion before us is the advancement of LB 119A to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 119A.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 119A is advanced to E & R Initial. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (LB) 243A, Mr. President, by Senator Janssen. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Chair recognizes Senator Janssen, to open on LB 243A.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor, members of the Legislature. (LB) 243A is the appropriations bill to follow the National Guard tuition bill along. Appropriates \$862,900 from General Fund for the Fiscal Year '99-2000, and the next year, 2000 to 2001, would be \$933,545 in additional funds over and above what we have right now. I'd like your vote on this for the passage of this important A bill. Thank you.
