PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 446 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 8 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 4 is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 5 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
