PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. Seeing no lights, you're recognized to close. Senator Wickersham, you're...

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Just ask you to be very positive for a negative.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The motion before us is the advancement of LB 669A to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 669A.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 669A is advanced to E & R Initial. LB 291 (sic), Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (LB) 291A, Mr. President, by Senator Chris Peterson. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Chair recognizes Senator Chris Peterson to open on LB 291A.

SENATOR C. PETERSON: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body, and to continue the forward movement this bill, LB 291A, has a positive fiscal note. LB 291A provides for a transfer of funds to carry out the provisions of LB 291, which provides for the issuance of permanent license plates for trucks and truck tractors. It does have a positive fiscal note, plus the industry all agreed to the increase in the plate fee because of the efficiencies that will be generated by not having to distribute the plates every three years. So I ask for your support in advancing LB 291A.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Peterson. If I could ask members to please take their conversations off the floor. Seeing no lights, Senator Peterson, you're recognized to close.
