PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The confirmation report is adopted. Mr. Clerk, General File appropriations bills.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 20A, by Senator Landis. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Chair recognizes Senator Landis, to open on LB 20A.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. The accompanying bill is the bill that creates the drivers...I'm sorry, the motor vehicle plates that have the handicap designation for motorcycle riders. Because it will require going back into our computer programming to allow for these to be issued, there is an A bill. The A bill is about \$7,000. I've got to think that this, in fact, is overstated. We will be in this department's computer programming at the end of this session because of other bills in front of the Transportation Committee and I expect the cost to drop, but, at this point, you have to account for each and every change and, for that reason, there is an A bill to LB 20. I would ask for its advancement to keep with the bill and then, of course it will be hung up there on Select File as we wrestle with the matters of the budget later in the session. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Landis. Seeing no lights, Senator, you're recognized to close. Senator Landis waives closing. The motion before us is the advancement of LB 20A to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 20A.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 20A is advanced to E & R Initial. Mr. Clerk.
