PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The motion before us is the adoption of the committee amendments. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 0 ayes, 28 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The committee amendments are not adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Move to amend with floor amendment 17, Senator, strike Section 2 of the bill.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Mr. President, the amendment that's before us would simply strike Section 2, which is the entire section dealing with closed sessions in staff executive sessions. Simply ask the body to vote green on this amendment which would strike Section 2.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. Discussion on the Bromm amendment. Seeing none, Senator Bromm, you're recognized to close. Senator Bromm waives closing on his amendment to LB 514. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Bromm's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Discussion on the advancement of LB 514. Senator Bromm, you're recognized to close on the advancement of 514.

SENATOR BROMM: Can I speak on the bill without closing? I've got my light lit. Did I not have my light on quickly enough?
